The Partnership seeks an analytical, detail-oriented, enthusiastic and self-motivated team member to assist in managing the collection, analysis, interpretation, presentation, and dissemination of data to support Partnership activities in improving student outcomes. The Analytics Associate will report to the Director of Analytics and work closely with all 20 members of the Commit! team, whose work ranges from Early Childhood to College Access & Success. The Associate will have access to great learning experiences with opportunities to stretch themselves and will be exposed to high-impact education work.

Responsibilities

- Plan and execute data analysis and research leading to actionable insights
- Develop reports and presentations for partners at the school district, community, and state-level to highlight successes, needs, and progress toward goals
- Manage the collection, aggregation, and synthesis of student achievement data from the Texas Education Agency and other sources
- Assist coaching of external partners to increase their data capabilities
- Work extensively in Excel and potentially VBA, SQL, or C# as necessary

Qualifications

- 2+ years of relevant experience preferred, entry-level considered
- BA/BS degree from a competitive university with a strong academic record
- Strong analytical skills; proficiency in MS Excel required, and database design or programming experience preferred
- Highly detail-oriented and a self-starter; accuracy is a must
- Solid communication and interpersonal skills; strong written communication skills—in email, Word, and PowerPoint—as well as chart development skills
- Ability to operate with an open mind, sense of urgency, and humility
- Insatiable desire to transform student achievement in the North Texas region and belief that education improves the odds for all children in service of Commit!'s mission
